

### **Accreditation course for the 2-channel gait correction stimulator**

This one and a half day course is intended to provide participants with the skills to set-up and use the Odstock 2-Channel Stimulator to correct for more complex gait deficits.

The course will be led by experienced FES clinicians and is aimed at healthcare professionals who have already attended the '**Accreditation course for the single channel stimulator [ODFS-Pace] used in dropped foot and gait correction**' and have some experience of its use. Teaching is through some taught sessions, including a review of the basic theory, but there is also a large practical content where participants will be able to use the stimulators on themselves and on patient volunteers. These practical sessions will therefore reinforce the theory. Each participant will receive course notes and further information to support their learning. After the course, participants are able to retain the stimulator on a 2 month free-loan.

Participants completing this course will receive an Accreditation Certificate from the National Clinical FES Centre in Salisbury. Accreditation provides that person with the qualification to be able to purchase and prescribe the Odstock 2-Channel Stimulator (O2CHS); training is therefore mandatory.

Course participants should be prepared to try the applications on themselves before trying them on patients. Please therefore bring a pair of shorts.
