

Accreditation course for the single channel stimulator [ODFS-Pace] used in dropped foot and gait correction

This two-day course is intended to enable participants to assess patients for FES treatment and provide them with the skills to set-up and use the dropped foot stimulator for gait correction.

The course will be led by experienced FES clinicians and is aimed at healthcare professionals. Teaching is through some taught sessions, but there is also a large practical content where participants will be able to use the stimulator on themselves and on patient volunteers. These practical sessions will therefore reinforce the theory. Each participant will receive a course folder and CD containing further information to support their learning.

Participants completing this course will receive an Accreditation Certificate from the National Clinical FES Centre in Salisbury. Accreditation provides that person with the qualification to be able to purchase and prescribe the ODFS-Pace device; training is therefore mandatory.

Course participants should be prepared to try the applications on themselves before trying them on patients. Please therefore bring a pair of shorts and a loose top or t-shirt.
